

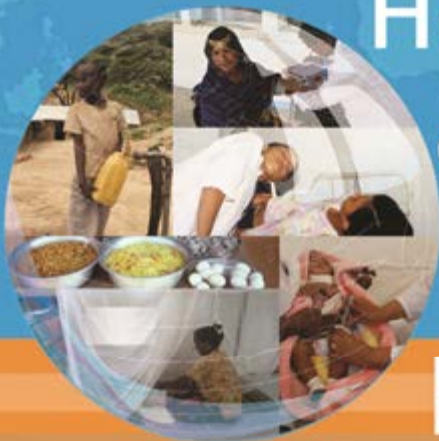

Message from the President of WFPHA



Dear participants of the 13th World Congress on Public Health

A warm welcome to all of you coming from all over the world to this fascinating country, Ethiopia with its 3000 and more years of history and to our tri-annual congress, this year under the general theme “Towards Global Health Equity: Opportunities and Threats”. Of course, three years before the deadline for the achievement of the Millennium Goals in 2015, their present status will be one of the key topics already on the first day of the full programme, that is Tuesday 24 April 2012. The Regional Director for the African Region of the World Health Organisation Dr. Luis G. Sambo will open the debate in the morning plenary. The next day is devoted to the continuing global health inequity, between the North and South and between regions and population groups. What can our Federation do about it? We can foster global and regional cooperation between public health professionals, governments and non-governmental organizations working for health. Therefore, we devote the last two days (Thursday and Friday) of the congress week to these topics. The five plenaries as well as the more than one hundred pre-organised and free sessions on the multiplicity of public health themes will provide ample opportunity to exchange opinions and learn from each other. I am especially proud that the foundation of the African Federation of Public Health Associations has been achieved last year and similar developments take place in the western Pacific, South Asia and the Middle East.

The World Federation has to take leadership in the quest for a healthy global society comprising the Right to Health, Social Justice, Diversity and Inclusion, Partnership, and Ethical Conduct. The dangers for the health of our populations are obvious: Climate change, armed conflicts, extreme poverty and hunger, poor health services, inefficiency of global aid and last but not least still ravaging infectious diseases like Malaria, Aids and Tuberculosis as well as increasingly the non communicable diseases with premature death due to myocardial infarction, stroke and cancer. In addition many other topics of high interest will be presented as for example the emerging public health genomics.

However, you will find also a rich cultural programme starting from the Opening ceremony on the afternoon of Monday 23 April and the subsequent reception as well as the cultural evening on Thursday and multiple sight-seeing offers during the Congress in Addis Ababa (where in the National Museum the skeleton of famous Lucy is hosted) as well as after the Congress to visit the historical places of Aksum, Gondar and Lalibela.

I wish you a pleasant stay in Addis Ababa and many new insights and new friendships!

Message from the President of EPHA



Dear Participants of the 13th World Congress on Public Health

On behalf of the Ethiopian Public Health Association, the host of the 13th World Congress on Public Health, and on my own, I greet you with a hearty welcome to Ethiopia. This is the home of Lucy. It is also a country with one of the oldest civilization, history, rich culture, mosaic landscape and complex biodiversity. At this juncture we wish to acknowledge with appreciation the fact that some of you have travelled long distances to be in Addis Abeba for this Congress with the theme: *“Towards Global Health Equity: Opportunities and Threats”*. We have no doubt that your deliberation will be productive. And, we will strive to make your stay memorable given the hospitable people and scenic beauty of the country.

This is the second time that the World Congress is being held in Africa after fifteen years; and we take pride in hosting it. As you recall the first was in Arusha, Tanzania, in 1997. Since then, so much has changed in Africa and worldwide in the public health domain. The importance of socio-economic, environmental and political determinants of health has grown. In many developing countries, poverty is expressed as food insecurity, and high rates of maternal, new born and childhood deaths. There is also an increasing mortality from infectious diseases, most notably HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria not to mention the emerging pandemics. Demographic and epidemiological transitions combined with nutritional and behavioral changes in low-and middle-income countries, have created new trends in

health, where these countries now also bear the heavy burden from non-communicable diseases. Furthermore, their already inadequate health systems is weakened by the vast drain of skilled health workers that leave the countries which have invested in their training to join the ranks of the Diaspora.

The Millennium Declaration and its goals strongly affirm the central place of health in the development agenda as poverty contributes to poor health, and poor health perpetuates poverty. Hence the achievement of the MDGs require concerted strategic approaches aimed at increasing equitable and sustainable access of the world's population, specifically the poor, to quality essential health services. Thus, it is encouraging to note that this Congress is taking place at a critical time when the global community is making a close watch of the progress being made in the achievement of the time-bound targets. This is only three years away!

The Congress, therefore, provides an excellent opportunity to address these critical issues through evidence-based and transparent interaction among the global public health community such that they and other key stakeholders would benefit from the knowledge gained and experience exchanged. Ultimately, the consensus reached as *"The Addis Ababa Declaration"* would be tabled for subsequent action at a global platform. Hence, we are confident that with the re-enforcement of our commitment we can jointly forge ahead in partnership with the public and private sectors, coupled with the sustained active participation of communities enriched with indigenous knowledge and traditional wisdom. When the above are in concert with national, regional and international professional associations, there would be strengthened north-south and south-south collaborative networking to work for and usher equitable health development for all towards improved quality of life. To this

end I wish this Congress a great success. Finally my gratitude and thanks to all those who contributed to the realization of the Congress.

Bio-data of Hugh R. Leavell Lectureship Awardee

Prof Redda Tekle Haimanot



Prof Redda Tekle Haimanot is a founder of “Garbet Tehadiso Mahber” which is a non-Governmental organization. This institution was established after neurological disorders were evidenced through studies conducted in Ethiopia. The non-governmental organization presently operates in Southern Nations Nationalities and Peoples and Oromia Regional States serving over 2 million people. The institution provides screening, treatment and vocational skills training services for the disabled individuals.

As a professor in the Department of Internal Medicine of the Faculty of Medicine, Addis Ababa University, Prof Redda taught both under and post graduate students for over two decades. His outstanding contributions for the university were: establishment of the Neurology Department, Principal Investigator of epidemiological studies on neurological disorders, encouraging young clinicians and scientists to actively undertake operational research. Although retired from the university since 1997, Prof Redda holds an Emeritus position at the Medical Faculty where he continues to participate in teaching.

Prof Redda served as Vice President and President of the Pan African Association of Neurological Sciences (1992-1996) and closely worked with the World Federation Neurology to raise the number of neurologists in African countries so that better and

accessible neurological services will be made available to communities, particularly in epilepsy care.

Since 2007, he is a member of the National Steering Committee for the Mitigation of Fluorosis in Ethiopia. He worked as a vice Chairperson of the WHO African Regional Commission for the Certification of Polio Eradication in the African Region (1998-2007) and as a member of the Task Force on Immunization for the WHO Afro Region (2004 – 2007). He is a member of the task force on Global Campaign to Reduce the Burden of Headache since 2003. He also served as Vice President and President of the Pan African Association of Neurological Sciences (1992-1996).

He was also awarded honorary of doctorate from Umea University in 1994, WHO Quenum Award in 1997 and Senior Researcher Award from Ethiopian Public Health Association in 1997. He authored over 70 peer-reviewed publications which have clear insight and public health implications.

Margaret Hilson



Margaret Hilson has worked extensively in international development and public health for most of her professional career. She is the former Director of Global Health Programs of the Canadian Public Health Association where she served for 22 years. During that time she was active in the World Federation of Public Health Associations serving on numerous committees and as Federation President from 1999-2001 and as co-President from 2003-04. She has developed and supervised international public health projects which include strengthening of basic public health functions, primary health care services, national immunization, health promotion, and sexual health programs and policies.

Margaret is firmly committed to the special role to be played by civil society in partnership with national ministries of health in the achievement of national health goals and strategies as well as a consolidation of the respect for human rights. She has been a key NGO partner for the World Health Organization and PAHO and has organized on their behalf workshops and has participated in WHO's global panel of experts on Civil Society and Global Governance for Health. She also co-authored a chapter on Civil Society for a 2009 WHO publication on Global Health Governance.

A public health nurse by profession she has lived and worked in India and Central America in the early years of her career. During her tenure at CPHA she was instrumental in the creation of the Strengthening of Public Health Associations

(SOPHA) which has worked closely with associations in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean. For this work, CPHA was awarded WHO's Sasakawa Award in 1992. In particular, it was her privilege to see so many new public health associations formed in Africa and to see them grow to strength as is evidenced by the recent formation of a network of Francophone public health associations and by the second WFPHA International Congress to be held in Africa; the first in Tanzania and now the second in Ethiopia.

Her work has been recognized by honors received from the International Council of Nurses, the Pan American Health Organization, and the Canadian government through the awarding of the prestigious Order of Canada and most recently, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal.

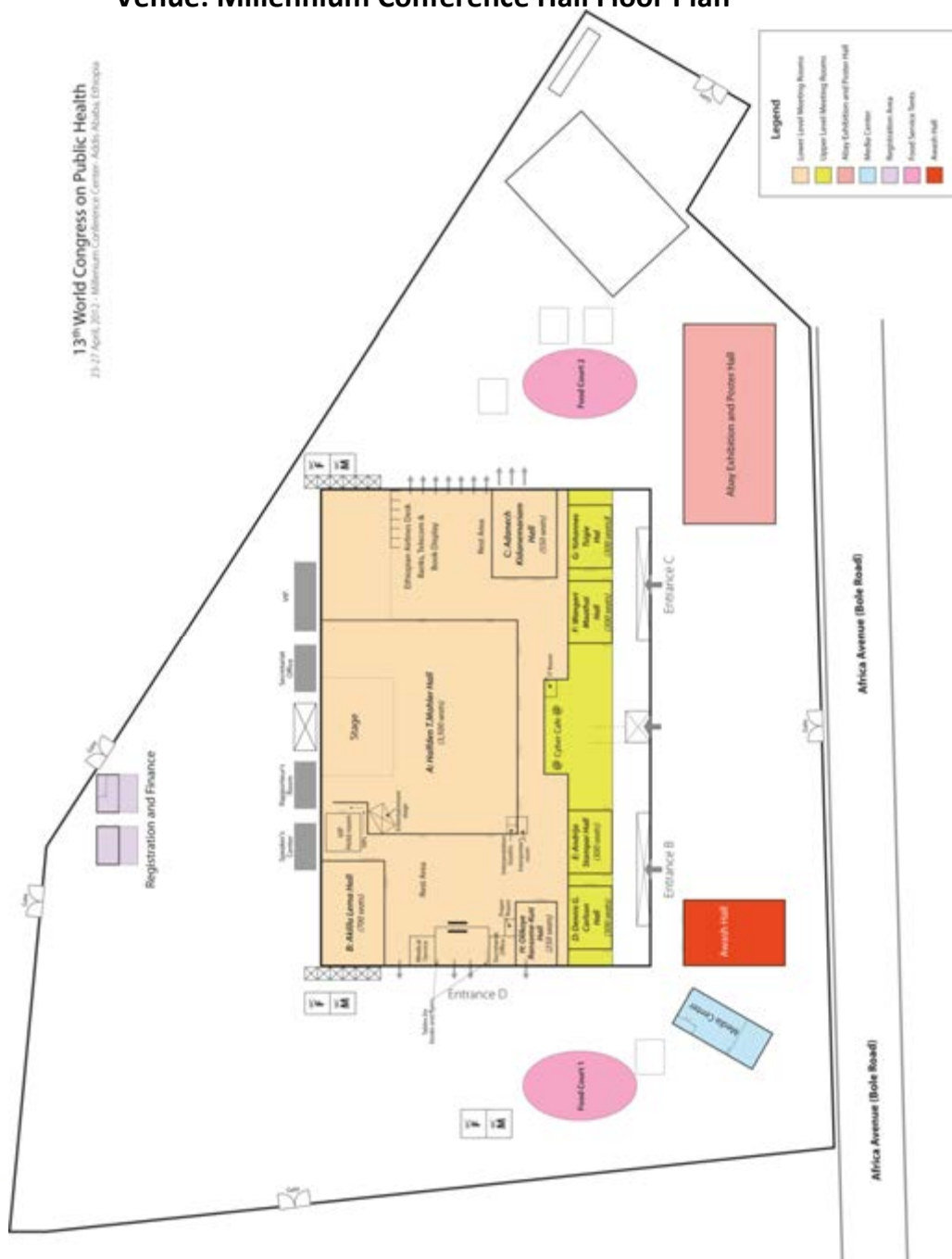
